

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE DISCLOSURE SCHEME CLARE'S LAW

IF YOU ARE WORRIED THAT YOU,
OR SOMEONE YOU KNOW,
MAY BE AT RISK OF DOMESTIC ABUSE...

...you can ask the
police to check
whether their current
or ex-partner has
a history of abusive
or violent behaviour.

This is known as making a 'Right to Ask' request under the Domestic Violence Disclosure Scheme (DVDS), also called Clare's Law.

Clare's Law covers all forms of domestic abuse – physical violence, controlling or coercive behaviour, economic or sexual abuse.
